Participant Rules and Responsibilities

The Granite Bay Flycasters club hosts many fish-outs through-out each year. The fish-outs are a fun, inexpensive way to fish new waters, learn new fishing tactics, and meet interesting, like-minded people. Our desire is that everyone is prepared and determined to have an enriching, relaxed and enjoyable time. To this end, there are a few rules we can all follow that will benefit everyone involved.

1. Supply the fish-out leader with the following information
 - a. Cell number where you can be reached on the day of the fish-out
 - b. Email address
 - c. Any need for instruction or guidance on the fishing style to be used
 - d. If this water is new to you, request a partner who is familiar with the area
 - e. For safety, it is wise to fish with a partner. If attending alone, notify the fish-out leader
2. Please respect the meet-up date and time. If you need to cancel the trip entirely, notify the fish-out leader as soon as possible. If you are going to be late, please call and advise the fish-out leader so others are not unnecessarily delayed. We all like to fish rather than eat donuts.
3. No guests who are not members of the Granite Bay Flycasters Club can attend the fish-outs. For legal reasons, this rule is strictly enforced.
4. When fishing with a partner, please respect the agreed upon meet-up time. We love helicopters and search dogs, just not at our fish-outs.
5. Respect the weather and dress appropriately for the conditions
6. Please bring the following
 - a. Water
 - b. Two-way radio with fresh batteries
 - c. A wading staff if fishing rivers or streams
 - d. Rod and reel appropriately sized for the water to be fished
 - e. Enthusiasm and a positive attitude
